Dairy Calf Meetings Interest Produuers

Last month, Akey Calf Nutrition Specialist, Dennis Wood (Ohio) visited Jones Feed Mills once again to update staff and customers on the latest information on dairy calf nutrition and rearing. Information sessions with both the Jones customer service and dairy teams were held to discuss general calf raising practices as well as what the Akey Nutrition research team is seeing through its calf research facility near Brookville Ohio. Farm visits and area barn meetings were also held to discuss calf raising issues with a focus on calf health and how producers can best manage various phases of growth. Dennis emphasized the need to provide proper nutrition through both milk replacer

and calf starter and stressed the importance of having the appropriate amount of starch and energy in a calf program to optimize the development of the rumen.
